



**Silver Spring, Maryland** – Courage Network participates in the Amnesty International Arts Festival with the Clothesline Project, April 23 – 25, 2010

Courage Network will be continuing a 20 year tradition with the Clothesline Project. The Clothesline Project honors women survivors as well as victims of intimate violence. The Project first began in 1990 with visual artist Rachel Carey-Harper in Cape Cod, Massachusetts. Moved by the power of the AIDS quilt, Rachel presented the concept of using shirts - hanging on a clothesline - as the vehicle for raising awareness about this issue.

Courage Network will participate in the event beginning on April 23<sup>rd</sup> and will host the display April 24th and 25<sup>th</sup>, Saturday and Sunday. Any woman who has experienced such domestic violence, at any time in her life, is encouraged to come forward and design a shirt. Victim's families and friends are also invited to participate.

The concept is to let each woman tell her story in her own unique way, using words and/or artwork to decorate her shirt. Once finished, she hangs her shirt on the clothesline. This process acts as an educational tool for those who come to view the Clothesline; it becomes a healing tool for anyone who make a shirt - by hanging the shirt on the line, survivors, friends and family can literally turn their back on some of that pain of their experience and walk away; finally it allows those who are still suffering in silence to understand that they are not alone. <a href="https://www.clotheslineproject.org">www.clotheslineproject.org</a>
